He follows me round the house. He hates being in his cage so I only use it to take him to the vet's. I'm sure he thinks he's a guard dog. He never follows me upstairs to bed at night but finds a quiet place downstairs where he can settle down and sleep: under the stairs, in a corner somewhere.'

The Police, who have been looking into the break-in, have already arrested one of the gang. 

Parts of a Dog

Parts of a dog

The back end of the dog is called the <u>rump</u>. The rump is near the tail and is above the dog's back legs.

The **brisket** is the area of the dog's chest between the front legs.

The front part of the head, including the mouth and nose is called the muzzle.

The <u>hock</u> is like an ankle on the back leg of the dog. It is on the lower part of the leg at the back and the bone sticks out slightly.

Behind the head and neck of the dog are the <u>withers</u>. This is the top of the shoulder and is the highest point on the dog's back

The part of the head between the dog's eyes is called the **stop**.

Towards the back of the head is the <u>occiput</u>. This is the highest point of the dog's head. There are many nerves in this part of the head, which is why stroking a dog's head can help to keep it calm.

The <u>stifle</u> is like the knee of a dog. It is on the front of the back leg and is about half way between the hock and the rump.
